APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. 16 This subchapter applies to an insurer writing automobile insurance in 17 this state, including an insurance company, reciprocal or 18 19 interinsurance exchange, mutual insurance company, capital stock company, county mutual insurance company, Lloyd's plan, or other 20 entity. 21 Sec. 1952.352. DETERMINATION OF VALUE. (a) An insurer that 22 23 pays damages for a motor vehicle that has been declared a total loss shall determine the value of the motor vehicle at the time of loss 24

7 SECTION 3. Section 1952.352, Insurance Code, as added by 8 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered, 9 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2014. A 10 policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 11 2014, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 12 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 13 that purpose.
