A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the meeting of a governmental body held by
- 3 videoconference call.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsections (c), (e), (f), and (h), Section
- 6 551.127, Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A meeting of a state governmental body or a governmental
- 8 body that extends into three or more counties may be held by
- 9 videoconference call only if the member [a majority of the quorum]
- 10 of the governmental body presiding over the meeting is physically
- 11 present at one location of the meeting that is open to the public
- 12 during the open portions of the meeting.
- 13 (e) The notice of a meeting to be held by videoconference
- 14 call must specify as a location of the meeting the location where a
- 15 quorum of the governmental body will be physically present and
- 16 specify the intent to have a quorum present at that location, except
- 17 that the notice of a meeting to be held by videoconference call
- 18 under Subsection (c) must specify as a location of the meeting the
- 19 [each] location where the member [a majority of the quorum] of the
- 20 governmental body presiding over the meeting will be physically
- 21 present and specify the intent to have the member [a majority of the
- 22 quorum] of the governmental body presiding over the meeting present
- 23 at that location. The location where the member of the governmental
- 24 body presiding over the meeting is physically present [In addition,

- 1 the notice of the meeting must specify as a location of the meeting
- 2 each other location where a member of the governmental body who will
- 3 participate in the meeting will be physically present during the
- 4 meeting. Each of the locations | shall be open to the public during
- 5 the open portions of the meeting.
- 6 (f) Each portion of a meeting held by videoconference call
- 7 that is required to be open to the public shall be visible and
- 8 audible to the public at $\underline{\text{the}}$ [each] location specified under
- 9 Subsection (e). If a problem occurs that causes a meeting to no
- 10 longer be visible and audible to the public at that location, the
- 11 meeting must be recessed until the problem is resolved. If the
- 12 problem is not resolved in six hours or less, the meeting must be
- 13 <u>adjourned</u>.
- (h) The [Each] location specified under Subsection (e), and
- 15 each remote location from which a member of the governmental body
- 16 participates, shall have two-way communication with each other
- 17 location during the entire meeting. The face of each [Each]
- 18 participant in the videoconference call, while $\frac{1}{2}$ that participant is
- 19 speaking, shall be clearly visible, and the voice audible, to each
- 20 other participant and, during the open portion of the meeting, to
- 21 the members of the public in attendance at a location of the
- 22 meeting.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
