(a) 14 Notwithstanding any other law, including Chapter 251, Agriculture Code, a county may not adopt regulations relating to: 15 16 (1) the transfer, private ownership, keeping, licensing, or 17 transportation, registration of firearms, ammunition, or firearm supplies; or 18 (2) the discharge of a firearm at a sport shooting 19 20 range. 21 (b) The attorney general shall bring an action in the name 22 of the state to obtain a temporary or permanent injunction against a county adopting a regulation, other than a regulation under Section 23 24 236.003, in violation of this section.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
