A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the operation of state travel information centers by

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 204.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 204.003. TRAVEL INFORMATION CENTERS. (a) In this
- 8 section, "travel information center" means an information center
- 9 located at a principal gateway of this state that provides [The
- 10 department shall maintain and operate travel information centers at
- 11 the principal gateways to this state to provide] highway
- 12 information, travel guidance, and descriptive material designed to
- 13 assist the traveling public and stimulate travel to and within this
- 14 state.

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- 15 (b) The department shall issue a request for proposals to
- 16 private and nonprofit entities for the operation of a travel
- 17 information center.
- 18 <u>(c) The department shall maintain and operate the center as</u>
- 19 a rest area without staff if the department finds none of the offers
- 20 from its request for proposals acceptable or is unable to comply
- 21 with federal law in issuing a contract under this section.
- 22 <u>(d) This section does not apply to a travel information</u>
- 23 <u>center located at the State Capitol.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. Section 204.004, Transportation Code, is amended

- 1 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 204.004. PAYMENT OF COSTS. (a) The department may pay
- 3 from highway revenues the cost, including the administration and
- 4 operation cost, of:
- 5 (1) developing, publishing, and distributing
- 6 material; and
- 7 (2) maintaining and operating travel information
- 8 centers.
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(2), the department may
- 10 not pay from highway revenues the cost, including the
- 11 administration and operation cost, of operating a travel
- 12 information center on or after August 31, 2014, provided that the
- 13 department may pay for the cost of maintaining and operating a
- 14 travel information center as an unstaffed rest area.
- 15 SECTION 3. The Texas Department of Transportation shall
- 16 initiate the process of contracting the operation of travel
- 17 information centers to a private or nonprofit entity not later than
- 18 September 1, 2013. The department shall contract for the operation
- 19 of travel information centers or cease staffing the travel
- 20 information centers as required by Section 204.003, Transportation
- 21 Code, as amended by this Act, not later than August 31, 2014.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
