- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 403.0123 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 403.0123. COORDINATION OF CERTAIN STANDARDS AND
- 9 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "One-time payment" means a one-time allocation of
- 11 federal money, including stimulus money, to a state agency
- 12 appropriated by legislation other than an annual federal
- 13 <u>appropriations act.</u>
- 14 (2) "State agency" means a department, commission,
- 15 board, office, or other agency in the executive or legislative
- 16 branch of state government created by the constitution or a statute
- 17 of this state, including an institution of higher education as
- 18 <u>defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.</u>
- 19 (b) If at least 10 state agencies receive a combined total
- 20 of at least \$1 billion in one-time payments in a state fiscal year,
- 21 the comptroller shall establish standards and reporting
- 22 requirements, including performance benchmarks, required of each
- 23 state agency that receives a one-time payment. The comptroller
- 24 shall ensure that the standards and reporting requirements conform

- 1 to any federal standards and reporting requirements related to the
- 2 <u>one-time</u> payments. To the greatest extent practicable, the
- 3 comptroller shall eliminate or suspend a state reporting
- 4 requirement that is duplicative or unnecessary in light of the
- 5 standards and reporting requirements established under this
- 6 <u>section</u>.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
