An institution 12 of higher education may require a vehicle described by Subsection 13 (a) to display a parking permit issued by the institution 14 specifically for the purpose of implementing this subsection, but 15 may not charge a fee for the permit. This subsection does not 16 17 entitle a person to park a vehicle described by Subsection (a) in a parking space or area that has not been designated specifically for 18 persons with physical disabilities on the property of the 19 20 institution if the vehicle has not been granted or assigned a parking permit required by the institution. 21 22 (a-2) Subsection (a-1) does not apply to a parking space or
