- 16 (b) A school district that provides transportation services
- 17 for students under Subsection (a)(1) is entitled to reimbursement
- 18 based on the number of actual miles traveled times the per mile rate
- 19 <u>authorized by Section 42.155(f).</u>
- 20 <u>(c) A school district in which a student resides that</u>
- 21 provides transportation to and from a site in accordance with
- 22 Subsection (a)(2) is entitled to reimbursement based on the number
