1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to transportation of certain students entitled to a public
 1-21 education grant.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 29.2021 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 29.2021. TRANSPORTATION. (a) The school district in
 1-26 which a student resides shall:

1-27 (1) provide to each student attending another school
 1-28 in the district under this subchapter transportation free of charge
 1-29 to and from the school the student attends; and

1-30 (2) provide to each student attending a school in a
 1-31 contiguous district under this subchapter transportation free of
 1-32 charge to and from a site on which the contiguous district and the
 1-33 district in which the student resides mutually agree.

1-34 (b) A school district that provides transportation services
 1-35 for students under Subsection (a)(1) is entitled to reimbursement
 1-36 based on the number of actual miles traveled times the per mile rate
 1-37 authorized by Section 42.155(f).

1-38 (c) A school district in which a student resides that
 1-39 provides transportation to and from a site in accordance with
 1-40 Subsection (a)(2) is entitled to reimbursement based on the number
 1-41 of actual miles traveled times the per mile rate authorized by
 1-42 Section 42.155(f).

1-43 (d) A school district contiguous to the district in which a
 1-44 student resides shall provide to each student that attends a school
 1-45 in the contiguous district transportation free of charge to and
 1-46 from the site described in Subsection (a)(2).

1-47 SECTION 2. Subsection (f), Section 29.203, Education Code,
 1-48 is repealed.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
