1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the authority to regulate certain water and sewage  
 1-24 utilities to ensure public safety in and around certain  
 1-25 municipalities.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 341.0358, Health and  
 1-28 Safety Code, is amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding  
 1-29 Subdivision (1-a) to read as follows:

1-30 (1) "Industrial district" has the meaning assigned by  
 1-31 Section 42.044, Local Government Code, and includes an area that is  
 1-32 designated by the governing body of a municipality as a zoned  
 1-33 industrial area.

1-34 (1-a) "Public utility" has the meaning assigned by  
 1-35 Section 13.002, Water Code.

1-36 SECTION 2. Subsection (g), Section 341.0358, Health and  
 1-37 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-38 (g) This section also applies to:

1-39 (1) a municipality with a population of more than  
 1-40 36,000 and less than 41,000 located in two counties, one of which is  
 1-41 a county with a population of more than 1.8 million;

1-42 (2) a municipality, including any industrial district  
 1-43 within the municipality or its extraterritorial jurisdiction, with  
 1-44 a population of more than 7,000 and less than 30,000 located in a  
 1-45 county with a population of more than 155,000 and less than 180,000;  
 1-46 and

1-47 (3) a municipality, including any industrial district  
 1-48 within the municipality or its extraterritorial jurisdiction, with  
 1-49 a population of more than 11,000 and less than 18,000 located in a  
 1-50 county with a population of more than 125,000 and less than 230,000.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
