7	Sec. 75.552. JUDICIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD. (a) The Office
8	of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System shall issue a
9	judicial identification card to each judge or justice of:
10	(1) a district court;
11	(2) a court of appeals;
12	(3) the court of criminal appeals; and
13	(4) the supreme court.
14	(b) The judicial identification card issued under
15	Subsection (a) must contain a photograph of the judge or justice and
16	identify the judge or justice as a member of the judiciary of the
17	State of Texas.
18	(c) An individual, corporation, or association may not deny
19	the holder of a judicial identification card access to goods,
20	services, or facilities, except as provided by Section 521.460,
21	Transportation Code, or in regard to the operation of a motor
22	vehicle, because the holder has a judicial identification card
23	rather than a driver's license. A judge or justice may use a
24	judicial identification card in the performance of the judge's or
