(1) the words "physical therapy," "physical therapist," "physiotherapy," "physiotherapist," "licensed physical therapist," "registered physical therapist," or "physical "licensed 1-29 1-30 therapist assistant"; 1-31

(2) the letters "PT," "PhT," "LPT," "RPT," "DPT," 1-32 <u>"MPT,"</u> or "PTA"; or (3) any other words, letters, abbreviations, 1-33

1-34 or insignia indicating or implying, by any means or in any way, that 1-35 1-36 physical therapy is provided or supplied.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
