A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to suspending public school accountability ratings and
- 3 certain interventions and sanctions for the 2012-2013 school year.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.116, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a), (b), (e), (f), and (g) and adding
- 7 Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) During the period of transition to the accreditation
- 9 system established under H.B. No. 3, Acts of the 81st Legislature,
- 10 Regular Session, 2009, to be implemented in August 2013, the
- 11 commissioner shall [may] suspend assignment of accreditation
- 12 statuses and performance ratings for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013
- 13 school <u>years</u> [year].
- 14 (b) As soon as practicable following the 2012-2013
- 15 [2011-2012] school year, the commissioner shall report district and
- 16 campus performance under the student achievement indicators under
- 17 Sections 39.053(c)(1)(A) and (B).
- 18 (e) During the 2011-2012, [and] 2012-2013, and 2013-2014
- 19 school years, the commissioner shall continue to implement
- 20 interventions and sanctions for districts and campuses identified
- 21 as having unacceptable performance in the 2010-2011 school year in
- 22 accordance with the performance standards applicable during the
- 23 2010-2011 school year and may increase or decrease the level of
- 24 interventions and sanctions based on an evaluation of the

- 1 district's or campus's performance.
- 2 (e-1) Subsection (e) does not apply to districts or campuses
- 3 that would have improved performance ratings had the performance
- 4 standards applicable during the 2012-2013 school year been in
- 5 effect in the 2010-2011 school year.
- 6 (f) For purposes of determining multiple years of
- 7 unacceptable performance and required district and campus
- 8 interventions and sanctions under this subchapter, the performance
- 9 ratings and accreditation statuses issued in the 2010-2011 and
- 10 2013-2014 [2012-2013] school years shall be considered
- 11 consecutive.
- 12 (g) This section expires September 1, 2015 [2014].
- SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 39.116, Education Code,
- 14 is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
