1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to suspending public school accountability ratings and
1-20 certain interventions and sanctions for the 2012-2013 school year.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 39.116, Education Code, is amended by
1-23 amending Subsections (a), (b), (e), (f), and (g) and adding
1-24 Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:

1-25 (a) During the period of transition to the accreditation
1-26 system established under H.B. No. 3, Acts of the 81st Legislature,
1-27 Regular Session, 2009, to be implemented in August 2013, the
1-28 commissioner shall ~~may~~ suspend assignment of accreditation
1-29 statuses and performance ratings for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013
1-30 school years [year].

1-31 (b) As soon as practicable following the 2012-2013
1-32 [2011-2012] school year, the commissioner shall report district and
1-33 campus performance under the student achievement indicators under
1-34 Sections 39.053(c)(1)(A) and (B).

1-35 (e) During the 2011-2012, [and] 2012-2013, and 2013-2014
1-36 school years, the commissioner shall continue to implement
1-37 interventions and sanctions for districts and campuses identified
1-38 as having unacceptable performance in the 2010-2011 school year in
1-39 accordance with the performance standards applicable during the
1-40 2010-2011 school year and may increase or decrease the level of
1-41 interventions and sanctions based on an evaluation of the
1-42 district's or campus's performance.

1-43 (e-1) Subsection (e) does not apply to districts or campuses
1-44 that would have improved performance ratings had the performance
1-45 standards applicable during the 2012-2013 school year been in
1-46 effect in the 2010-2011 school year.

1-47 (f) For purposes of determining multiple years of
1-48 unacceptable performance and required district and campus
1-49 interventions and sanctions under this subchapter, the performance
1-50 ratings and accreditation statuses issued in the 2010-2011 and
1-51 2013-2014 [2012-2013] school years shall be considered
1-52 consecutive.

1-53 (g) This section expires September 1, 2015 [2014].

1-54 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 39.116, Education Code,
1-55 is repealed.

1-56 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-57 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-58 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-59 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-60 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
