## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to matching private grants given to enhance additional 3 research activities at institutions of higher education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 62.123, 6 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:

gifts 7 (a) eligible institution that receives An or 8 endowments from private sources in a state fiscal year for the purpose of enhancing research activities at the institution, 9 10 including a gift or endowment for endowed chairs, professorships, facilities, equipment, program costs, [or] graduate stipends or 11 12 fellowships, or undergraduate research, is entitled to receive, out 13 of funds appropriated for the purposes of the program for that fiscal year, a matching grant in an amount determined according to 14 15 the following rates:

16 (1) 50 percent of the amount of the gifts and 17 endowments, if the total amount of gifts and endowments is \$100,000 18 or more but not more than \$999,999;

(2) 75 percent of the amount of the gifts and
endowments, if the total amount of gifts and endowments is \$1
million or more but not more than \$1,999,999; or

(3) 100 percent of the amount of the gifts and
endowments, if the total amount of gifts and endowments is \$2
million or more.

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1 (b) An eligible institution is not entitled to matching 2 funds under the program for: (1) a gift that has been pledged but has not been 3 received by the institution; 4 5 (2) a gift for undergraduate scholarships or <u>financial</u> 6 <u>aid</u> grants; or 7 any portion of gifts or endowments received by the (3) institution from a single source in a state fiscal year in excess of 8 \$10 million. 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 10

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
