Section 25.094(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 An individual commits an offense if the individual: 20 (a) 21 (1) is 12 years of age or older and younger than $\underline{21}$ 22 [18] years of age; 23 (2) is required to attend school under Section 25.085 24 or a school district policy adopted under that section; and

1 (3) fails to attend school on 10 or more days or parts 2 of days within a six-month period in the same school year or on 3 three or more days or parts of days within a four-week period.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
