## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the intercollegiate athletics fee at Prairie View A&M
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), and (f), Section 54.5393,
- 6 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:

University; authorizing an increase in the fee.

- 7 (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System
- 8 may impose an intercollegiate athletics fee on each student
- 9 enrolled at Prairie View A&M University in an amount not to exceed
- 10 \$12.60 [\$10] per semester credit hour, unless the amount is
- 11 increased as provided by Subsection (b).
- 12 (b) The amount of the fee per semester credit hour may be
- increased from one academic year to the next if:
- 14 (1) the increase is approved by a majority vote of the
- 15 students participating in a general student election held at the
- 16 university for that purpose; or
- 17 (2) the amount of the increase does not exceed five
- 18 percent and is approved by a majority vote of the legislative body
- 19 of the student government of the university [imposed on a student in
- 20 a semester or session may not exceed the amount of the fee imposed
- 21 on a student enrolled in 15 semester credit hours during the same
- 22 semester or session].

- 23 (f) This section expires September 1, 2018 [<del>2013</del>], except
- 24 that this section does not expire if before the end of the 2017-2018

- 1 [2012-2013] academic year the board of regents issues bonds that
- 2 are payable wholly or partly from the fee. If the board of regents
- 3 issues bonds as described by this subsection, the fee authorized by
- 4 this section may not be imposed in any semester or session beginning
- 5 after the date on which all of those bonds, including refunding
- 6 bonds for the bonds, have been fully paid.
- 7 SECTION 2. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 54.5393,
- 8 Education Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to a fee imposed
- 9 for a semester that begins on or after the effective date of this
- 10 Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
