## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the development of a statewide ST-segment elevation

3 myocardial infarction system of care plan.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a strong system for

6 ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction survival is needed in

7 the state's communities in order to treat ST-segment elevation

8 myocardial infarction victims in a timely manner and to build upon

9 and coordinate the overall treatment of ST-segment elevation

10 myocardial infarction victims. It is the intent of the legislature

11 to advance local and state efforts to improve the system for

12 ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction treatment by inviting

13 recommendations from leaders in public health and the ST-segment

14 elevation myocardial infarction system.

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15 SECTION 2. Section 773.012, Health and Safety Code, is

16 amended by adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:

17 (m) Not later than December 1, 2014, the advisory council,

18 with the assistance of the committee established under Subchapter I

19 and in collaboration with the Texas Council on Cardiovascular

20 Disease and Stroke, shall develop a statewide ST-segment elevation

21 myocardial infarction system of care plan that follows the American

22 Heart Association and American College of Cardiology guidelines and

23 addresses the appropriate triage, treatment, transport, and

24 rehabilitation of ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction

- 1 patients. Not later than December 1, 2014, the advisory council
- 2 shall submit a report to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the
- 3 speaker of the house of representatives, and the executive
- 4 commissioner containing the system of care plan developed under
- 5 this subsection. The executive commissioner may adopt rules to
- 6 implement the system of care plan contained in the report.
- 7 SECTION 3. Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Subchapter I to read as follows:
- 9 SUBCHAPTER I. ST-SEGMENT ELEVATION MYOCARDIAL INFARCTION
- 10 COMMITTEE
- 11 Sec. 773.251. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 12 (1) "Advisory council" means the advisory council
- 13 established under Section 773.012.
- 14 (2) "Committee" means the cardiac ST-segment
- 15 elevation myocardial infarction committee created under this
- 16 <u>subchapter</u>.
- 17 <u>Sec. 773.252. ST-SEGMENT ELEVATION MYOCARDIAL INFARCTION</u>
- 18 COMMITTEE. (a) The committee is composed of the following 10
- 19 members appointed by the advisory council:
- 20 (1) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 21 chapter of the American College of Cardiology;
- 22 (2) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 23 Hospital Association;
- 24 (3) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 25 Organization of Rural & Community Hospitals;
- 26 (4) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 27 College of Emergency Physicians;

- 1 (5) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 2 Medical Association;
- 3 (6) one member who is a representative of the American
- 4 Heart Association;
- 5 (7) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 6 EMS, Trauma, & Acute Care Foundation;
- 7 (8) one member who is a representative of the Texas
- 8 Emergency Nurses Association; and
- 9 (9) two members who are ST-segment elevation
- 10 myocardial infarction survivors or patient advocates.
- 11 (b) The committee shall assist the advisory council in
- 12 developing the statewide ST-segment elevation myocardial
- infarction system of care plan required by Section 773.012(m).
- Sec. 773.253. EXPIRATION. The committee is abolished and
- 15 this subchapter expires June 30, 2015.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
