- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 773.003, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (17-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (17-a) "Hospital" means a hospital licensed under
- 8 <u>Chapter 241.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 10 by adding Subchapter I to read as follows:
- 11 SUBCHAPTER I. ST SEGMENT ELEVATION MYOCARDIAL INFARCTION SERVICES
- 12 Sec. 773.251. ST SEGMENT ELEVATION MYOCARDIAL INFARCTION
- 13 FACILITIES. (a) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules for
- 14 designating a hospital as an ST segment elevation myocardial
- 15 infarction receiving center if the hospital has been accredited as
- 16 a Mission: Lifeline ST Segment Elevation Myocardial Infarction
- 17 Receiving Center by the Society for Cardiovascular Patient Care,
- 18 the American Heart Association, or another nationally recognized
- 19 organization that provides the accreditation.
- 20 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules for
- 21 designating a hospital as an ST segment elevation myocardial
- 22 infarction referral center if the hospital has been accredited as a
- 23 <u>Mission: Lifeline ST Segment Elevation Myocardial Infarction</u>
- 24 Referral Center by the Society for Cardiovascular Patient Care, the

- 1 American Heart Association, or another nationally recognized
- 2 organization that provides the accreditation.
- 3 (c) A hospital may apply to the department for designation
- 4 as an ST segment elevation myocardial infarction receiving center
- 5 or an ST segment elevation myocardial infarction referral center,
- 6 and the department shall grant the designation if the facility
- 7 meets the requirements for the designation under this section.
- 8 Sec. 773.252. SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF DESIGNATION. The
- 9 department may suspend or revoke a hospital's designation as an ST
- 10 segment elevation myocardial infarction receiving center or an ST
- 11 segment elevation myocardial infarction referral center, after
- 12 notice and hearing, if the department determines that the hospital
- 13 has not maintained the requirements for the designation under
- 14 Section 773.251.
- 15 SECTION 3. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 16 Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to
- 17 implement Subchapter I, Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code, as
- 18 added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2014.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
