- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 161.325, Health and Safety Code, is
- amended by adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) and amending 6
- Subsection (d) to read as follows: 7

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- (c-1) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, each 8
- 9 school district shall provide training described in the components
- set forth under Subsection (b) for teachers, counselors, 10
- principals, and all other appropriate personnel. A school district 11
- is required to provide the training at an elementary school campus 12
- only to the extent that sufficient funding and programs are 13
- 14 available. A school district may implement a program on the list to
- satisfy the requirements of this subsection. 15
- 16 (c-2) For any training under Subsection (c-1), each school
- district shall maintain records that include the name of each 17
- district employee who participated in the training. A school 18
- district employee described under Subsection (c-1) must 19
- participate in the training at least one time. 20
- 21 (d) The board of trustees of each school district shall
- 22 [may] adopt a policy concerning early mental health intervention
- 23 and suicide prevention that:
- 24 (1) establishes a procedure for providing notice of a

- 1 recommendation for early mental health intervention regarding a
- 2 student to a parent or guardian of the student within a reasonable
- 3 amount of time after the identification of early warning signs as
- 4 described by Subsection (b)(2);
- 5 (2) establishes a procedure for providing notice of a
- 6 student identified as at risk of committing suicide to a parent or
- 7 guardian of the student within a reasonable amount of time after the
- 8 identification of early warning signs as described by Subsection
- 9 (b)(2);
- 10 (3) establishes that the district may develop a
- 11 reporting mechanism and may designate at least one person to act as
- 12 a liaison officer in the district for the purposes of identifying
- 13 students in need of early mental health intervention or suicide
- 14 prevention; and
- 15 (4) sets out available counseling alternatives for a
- 16 parent or guardian to consider when their child is identified as
- 17 possibly being in need of early mental health intervention or
- 18 suicide prevention.
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter O-1, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
- 20 Code, is amended by adding Section 161.326 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 161.326. IMMUNITY. This subchapter does not:
- 22 (1) waive any immunity from liability of a school
- 23 district or of district school officers or employees;
- 24 (2) create any liability for a cause of action against
- 25 a school district or against district school officers or employees;
- 26 or
- 27 (3) waive any immunity from liability under Section

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- 1 74.151, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
