1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to testing of a juvenile for a sexually transmitted
 1-20 disease or human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) on the filing of a
 1-21 petition alleging delinquent conduct that includes certain sexual
 1-22 offenses.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 54.033, Family Code, is
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a) ~~A child against whom a petition is filed that alleges~~
 1-27 ~~the child [found at the conclusion of an adjudication hearing under~~
 1-28 ~~Section 54.03 of this code to have]~~ engaged in delinquent conduct
 1-29 that includes ~~[included]~~ a violation of Section ~~[Sections]~~
 1-30 21.11(a)(1), 22.011, or 22.021, Penal Code, shall undergo a medical
 1-31 procedure or test at the direction of the juvenile court designed to
 1-32 show or help show whether the child has a sexually transmitted
 1-33 disease, acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), human
 1-34 immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection, antibodies to HIV, or
 1-35 infection with any other probable causative agent of AIDS. The
 1-36 court may direct the child to undergo the procedure or test on the
 1-37 court's own motion or on the request of the victim of the delinquent
 1-38 conduct.

1-39 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
 1-40 petition alleging delinquent conduct filed on or after the
 1-41 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the alleged
 1-42 delinquent conduct occurred before, on, or after the effective date
 1-43 of this Act.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
