 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to a contract for the acquisition of goods or services to
 1-18 which The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center is a
 1-19 party.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 73.115, Education Code, is amended by
 1-22 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

1-23 (g) In any contract for the acquisition of goods or services
 1-24 to which the institution is a party, a provision required by
 1-25 applicable law to be included in the contract is considered to be a
 1-26 part of the executed contract without regard to:

1-27 (1) whether the provision appears on the face of the
 1-28 contract; or

1-29 (2) whether the contract includes any provision to the
 1-30 contrary.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
