## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to development of a pilot program of the Texas Veterans
- 3 Commission to designate municipalities as Veteran and Military
- 4 Friendly Cities.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 434.022 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 434.022. PILOT PROGRAM TO DESIGNATE VETERAN AND
- 9 MILITARY FRIENDLY CITIES. (a) The commission may develop a pilot
- 10 program to designate qualifying municipalities as Veteran and
- 11 Military Friendly Cities. The commission may establish the
- 12 criteria to qualify for a designation under the pilot program
- 13 <u>developed under this section</u>.
- 14 <u>(b) The criteria established under Subsection (a) must</u>
- 15 include an evaluation of a municipality's ability to provide
- 16 services for veterans and members of the military, taking into
- 17 consideration the availability in the municipality of:
- 18 (1) a local or county veterans service office;
- (2) suitable housing for veterans and members of the
- 20 <u>military;</u>
- 21 (3) financial support for veterans and members of the
- 22 military;
- 23 (4) employment resources for veterans and members of
- 24 the military;

- 1 (5) education and training programs for veterans and 2 members of the military;
- 3 (6) a veterans court; and
- (7) access to health care for veterans, including
  mental health services and mental health services peer-to-peer
  networks.
- 7 <u>(c) The commission may accept and review applications for</u> 8 the designation and issue tiered designations, as appropriate.
- 9 (d) The commission may by rule establish a procedure for
  10 discouraging and preventing the misappropriation of the phrase
  11 "Veteran and Military Friendly City."
- 12 <u>(e) The commission shall report the results of the pilot</u>
  13 <u>program under this section to the governor, the lieutenant</u>
  14 <u>governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the</u>
  15 <u>committees in both houses of the legislature having jurisdiction</u>
  16 <u>over veterans and military issues not later than December 31, 2014.</u>
- 17 <u>(f)</u> This section expires September 1, 2015.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
