| 12 | criteria to qualify for a designation under the pilot program |

| 14 | (b) The criteria established under Subsection (a) must |
| 15 | include evaluation of a municipality's ability to provide services |
| 16 | for veterans and members of the military, taking into consideration |
| 17 | the availability in the municipality of: |
| 18 | (1) a local or county veterans service office; |
| 19 | (2) suitable housing for veterans and members of the |

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(4) employment resources for veterans and members of

- 3 (6) a veterans court; and
- 4 (7) access to health care for veterans, including

- 7 <u>(c) The commission may accept and review applications for</u>
- 8 the designation and issue tiered designations, as appropriate.
- 9 (d) The commission may by rule establish a procedure for
- 10 discouraging and preventing the misappropriation of the phrase
- 11 "Veteran and Military Friendly City."
- 12 (e) The commission shall report the results of the pilot
- 13 program under this section to the governor, the lieutenant
- 14 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 15 committees in both houses of the legislature having jurisdiction
- 16 over veterans and military issues not later than December 31, 2014.
- 17 (f) This section expires September 1, 2015.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
