- 19 (4) an unexpired Certificate of United States
- 20 Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, United States Citizen
- 21 Identification Card, Permanent Resident Card, Temporary Resident
- 22 Card, Employment Authorization Card, or other document issued by
- 23 the federal Department of Homeland Security or the United States

- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to an application for a marriage license submitted to a county clerk
- 11 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 12 marriage license submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 13 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
- 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
