1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the proof of an applicant's identity and age required
 1-19 for the issuance of a marriage license.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 2.005, Family Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (b) The proof must be established by:

1-24 (1) a driver's license or identification card issued
 1-25 by this state, another state, or a foreign government [~~Canadian~~
 1-26 ~~province~~] that is current or has expired not more than two years
 1-27 preceding the date the identification is submitted to the county
 1-28 clerk in connection with an application for a license;

1-29 (2) a United States passport that is current or has
 1-30 expired not more than two years preceding the date the passport is
 1-31 submitted to the county clerk in connection with an application for
 1-32 a license;

1-33 (3) a current passport issued by a foreign country or a
 1-34 consular document issued by a state or national government;

1-35 (4) an unexpired Certificate of United States
 1-36 Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, United States Citizen
 1-37 Identification Card, Permanent Resident Card, Temporary Resident
 1-38 Card, Employment Authorization Card, or other document issued by
 1-39 the federal Department of Homeland Security or the United States
 1-40 Department of State that contains the person's [~~including an~~
 1-41 ~~identification~~] photograph;

1-42 (5) an unexpired military identification card for
 1-43 active duty, reserve, or retired personnel that contains the
 1-44 person's [~~with an identification~~] photograph;

1-45 (6) [~~an original or certified copy of a birth~~

 1-47 ~~foreign government;~~

 2-2 (7) an unexpired [~~(14) an original or certified copy~~
 2-3 ~~of the applicant's marriage license or divorce decree,~~
 2-4 [~~(15) a voter registration certificate,~~
 2-5 [~~(16) a~~] pilot's license issued by the Federal
 2-6 Aviation Administration or another authorized agency of the United
 2-7 States that contains the person's photograph;
 2-8 (8) an unexpired [~~(17) a~~] license to carry a
 2-9 concealed handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code;
 2-10 (9) [~~(18)~~] a temporary driving permit or a temporary
 2-11 identification card issued by the Department of Public Safety,
 2-12 together with an identification photograph; or
 2-13 (10) [~~(19)~~] an offender identification card issued by
 2-14 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice that contains the person's
 2-15 photograph.

2-16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 2-17 to an application for a marriage license submitted to a county clerk
 2-18 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
 2-19 marriage license submitted before the effective date of this Act is
 2-20 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
 2-21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

2-22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
