A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for firearms and hunting
- 3 supplies for a limited period.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.358 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.358. FIREARMS AND HUNTING SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED
- 8 PERIOD. (a) In this section, "hunting supplies" means ammunition,
- 9 archery equipment, hunting blinds and stands, hunting decoys,
- 10 firearm cleaning supplies, gun cases and gun safes, and hunting
- 11 optics.
- 12 (b) The sale of a firearm or hunting supplies is exempted
- 13 from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes place
- 14 during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on March 2 and ending at 12
- 15 midnight on the same day.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 17 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 18 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 19 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 20 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 21 the liability for those taxes.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
