- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.305(b), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The commissioners court of a county may adopt a district
- 9 court records archive fee of not more than \$10 [\$5] for the filing
- 10 of a suit, including an appeal from an inferior court, or a
- 11 cross-action, counterclaim, intervention, contempt action, motion
- 12 for new trial, or third-party petition, in a district court in the
- 13 county as part of the county's annual budget. The fee must be set
- 14 and itemized in the county's budget as part of the budget
- 15 preparation process and must be approved in a public meeting. The
- 16 fee is for preservation and restoration services performed in
- 17 connection with maintaining a district court records archive.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.317(b), Government Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:

- SECTION 4. Sections 118.011(b) and (f), Local Government

- 1 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 2 (b) The county clerk may set and collect the following fee

- 5 than \$15 or more than \$30
- 6 (2) Records Management and Preservation Fee (Sec.

- 10 (f) The county clerk of a county shall, if the commissioners

- 15 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 16 a fee that becomes payable on or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. A fee that becomes payable before the effective date of this
- 18 Act is governed by the law in effect when the fee became payable,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 6. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 21 over another Act of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013,
- 22 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 23 codes.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
