- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 345.251, Finance Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (c) and adding Subsection (e) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) A retail seller may charge a documentary fee for
- 9 services rendered to, for, or on behalf of a retail buyer in
- 10 [$\frac{preparing_{\tau}}{r}$] handling[$\frac{1}{\tau}$] and processing documents relating to the
- 11 sale of[, and closing a retail installment transaction involving,]
- 12 a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, moped, all-terrain vehicle,
- 13 boat, boat motor, boat trailer, or towable recreational vehicle.
- 14 (b) If a documentary fee is charged under this section the
- 15 fee:
- 16 (1) must be charged to cash buyers and credit buyers;
- 17 (2) may not exceed <u>a reasonable amount agreed to by the</u>
- 18 retail seller and retail buyer for the documentary services,
- 19 subject to a reasonable maximum amount set by rule by the finance
- 20 commission [\$50]; and
- 21 (3) must be disclosed on the <u>buyer's order or</u> retail
- 22 installment contract as a separate itemized charge.
- 23 (c) A preliminary work sheet on which a sale price is
- 24 computed and that is shown to the retail buyer, an order from the

- 1 buyer, or a retail installment contract must include in reasonable
- 2 proximity to the place on the document where the documentary fee is
- 3 disclosed:
- 4 (1) the amount of the fee; and
- 5 (2) the following notice in type that is bold-faced,
- 6 capitalized, or underlined or otherwise conspicuously set out from
- 7 the surrounding written material:
- 8 "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A
- 9 DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE
- 10 CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING DOCUMENTS [AND
- 11 PERFORMING SERVICES RELATING TO THE [CLOSING OF A]
- 12 SALE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED A REASONABLE
- AMOUNT AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES THAT IS NOT MORE THAN
- 14 THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT ALLOWED BY THE STATE [\$50]. THIS
- 15 NOTICE IS REQUIRED BY LAW."
- (e) The finance commission may adopt rules necessary to
- 17 implement and enforce this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
