## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to improving access to nursing education programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 4 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 51.762,
- 5 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The board, with the assistance of an advisory committee
- 7 composed of representatives of general academic teaching
- 8 institutions, junior college districts, public state colleges, and
- 9 public technical institutes, and with the consultation of all
- 10 institutions of higher education that admit freshman-level
- 11 students:

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- 12 (1) shall adopt by rule:
- 13 (A) a common admission application form for use
- 14 by a person seeking admission as a freshman student to a general
- 15 academic teaching institution; [and]
- 16 (B) an electronic common admission application
- 17 form for use by a person seeking admission as a freshman student to
- 18 an institution of higher education that admits freshman-level
- 19 students, other than a general academic teaching institution; and
- (C) if the board determines that adoption of the
- 21 form would be cost-effective for nursing schools, an electronic
- 22 common admission application form for use by a person seeking
- 23 admission as a student to an undergraduate nursing education
- 24 program at an institution of higher education; and

- 1 (2) may adopt by rule a printed format common
- 2 admission application form for use by a person seeking admission as
- 3 a freshman student to an institution of higher education that
- 4 admits freshman-level students, other than a general academic
- 5 teaching institution.
- 6 (b) The board, with the assistance of an advisory committee
- 7 composed of representatives of general academic teaching
- 8 institutions, junior college districts, public state colleges, and
- 9 public technical institutes, and with the consultation of all
- 10 institutions of higher education that admit undergraduate transfer
- 11 students, may adopt by rule:
- 12 (1) a common admission application form for use by a
- 13 person seeking admission as an undergraduate transfer student to a
- 14 general academic teaching institution; [and]
- 15 (2) an electronic or printed format common admission
- 16 application form for use by a person seeking admission as an
- 17 undergraduate transfer student to an institution of higher
- 18 education that admits undergraduate transfer students, other than a
- 19 general academic teaching institution; and
- 20 (3) if the board determines that adoption of the form
- 21 would be cost-effective for nursing schools, an electronic common
- 22 admission application form for use by a person seeking admission as
- 23 a transfer student to an undergraduate nursing education program at
- 24 an institution of higher education.
- 25 SECTION 2. Section 61.026, Education Code, is amended to
- 26 read as follows:
- Sec. 61.026. COMMITTEES AND ADVISORY COMMITTEES. (a) The

- 1 chairman may appoint committees from the board's membership as the
- 2 <u>chairman</u> [he] or the board may find necessary from time to time.
- 3 The board may appoint advisory committees from outside its
- 4 membership as it may deem necessary.
- 5 (b) If the board directs an advisory committee to assist the
- 6 board in exercising its authority under Section 61.051(j) regarding
- 7 an off-campus course in nursing education, including clinical
- 8 coursework, the board shall require the advisory committee to
- 9 <u>include or consult with one or more for-profit career schools</u>
- 10 offering nursing education courses in the area where the course is
- 11 to be offered.
- 12 SECTION 3. Chapter 61, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 13 Subchapter II to read as follows:
- 14 SUBCHAPTER II. NURSING FACULTY LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- 15 Sec. 61.9821. REPAYMENT AUTHORIZED. The board shall
- 16 establish and administer a program to provide, in accordance with
- 17 this subchapter and board rules, assistance in the repayment of
- 18 student loans for nurses who:
- 19 (1) are serving on the faculties of nursing degree
- 20 programs at institutions of higher education or private or
- 21 independent institutions of higher education in positions that
- 22 require an advanced degree in professional nursing; and
- (2) apply and qualify for the assistance.
- Sec. 61.9822. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible to receive loan
- 25 repayment assistance under this subchapter, a nurse must:
- 26 <u>(1) apply to the board;</u>
- 27 (2) at the time of application for repayment

- 1 assistance have been employed full-time for at least one year as,
- 2 and be currently employed full-time as, a faculty member of a
- 3 nursing degree program at an institution of higher education or a
- 4 private or independent institution of higher education; and
- 5 (3) comply with any additional requirements adopted by
- 6 board rule.
- 7 Sec. 61.9823. LIMITATIONS. (a) On qualifying for loan
- 8 repayment assistance under this subchapter, a nurse may receive
- 9 repayment assistance for each year of full-time employment as a
- 10 faculty member of a nursing degree program at an institution of
- 11 higher education or private or independent institution of higher
- 12 education, not to exceed five years.
- 13 (b) The amount of loan repayment assistance received by a
- 14 nurse under this subchapter may not exceed \$7,000 in any one year.
- 15 (c) The total amount of loan repayment assistance provided
- 16 under this subchapter may not exceed the total amount of gifts and
- 17 grants accepted by the board for the repayment assistance and other
- 18 funds available to the board for the repayment assistance,
- 19 including any money reallocated under Section 61.9826.
- Sec. 61.9824. ELIGIBLE LOANS. (a) The board may provide
- 21 repayment assistance for the repayment of any student loan for
- 22 education at any public or private institution of higher education,
- 23 including a loan for undergraduate education, received by an
- 24 eligible person through any lender.
- 25 (b) The board may not provide repayment assistance for a
- 26 student loan that is in default at the time of the nurse's
- 27 application.

- 1 Sec. 61.9825. REPAYMENT. (a) The board shall deliver any
- 2 repayment under this subchapter in a lump sum:
- 3 (1) payable to both the lender or other holder of the
- 4 loan and the nurse; or
- 5 (2) directly to the lender or other holder of the loan
- 6 on the nurse's behalf.
- 7 (b) A repayment under this subchapter may be applied to any
- 8 amount due in connection with the loan.
- 9 <u>Sec. 61.9826. REALLOCATION OF MONEY.</u> (a) In each state
- 10 fiscal year, the board shall reallocate for loan repayment
- 11 assistance under this subchapter for a particular year any money in
- 12 the physician education loan repayment program account established
- 13 under Section 61.5391 that exceeds the amount necessary in that
- 14 fiscal year for purposes of repayment assistance under Subchapter
- 15 J.
- 16 (b) Any money reallocated under Subsection (a) in a fiscal
- 17 year that is not used for loan repayment assistance under this
- 18 subchapter in that fiscal year is treated as if that unused amount
- 19 had not been reallocated in that fiscal year.
- Sec. 61.9827. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The board may solicit and
- 21 accept gifts and grants from any source for the purposes of this
- 22 <u>subchapter</u>.
- Sec. 61.9828. RULES. (a) The board shall adopt rules as
- 24 necessary to administer this subchapter.
- 25 (b) The board shall distribute a copy of the rules adopted
- 26 under this section and pertinent information regarding this
- 27 subchapter to:

- 1 (1) each institution of higher education and private
- 2 or independent institution of higher education;
- 3 (2) any appropriate state agency; and
- 4 (3) any appropriate professional association.
- 5 SECTION 4. Subsection (b), Section 61.5391, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Money in the account may not be appropriated for any
- 8 purpose except:
- 9 (1) to provide loan repayment assistance to eligible
- 10 physicians under this subchapter; or
- 11 (2) to provide loan repayment assistance under
- 12 Subchapter II if reallocated under Section 61.9826.
- 13 SECTION 5. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 14 shall adopt the rules for loan repayment assistance under
- 15 Subchapter II, Chapter 61, Education Code, as added by this Act, not
- 16 later than December 1, 2013.
- SECTION 6. Not later than September 1, 2014, the Texas
- 18 Higher Education Coordinating Board shall make an initial
- 19 determination regarding whether adopting electronic common
- 20 admission application forms for undergraduate nursing education
- 21 programs would be cost-effective as required by Subsections (a) and
- 22 (b), Section 51.762, Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
