 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the certification of sheriffs and deputy sheriffs to
 1-20 enforce commercial motor vehicle safety standards in certain
 1-21 counties.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 644.101, Transportation
 1-24 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-25 (c) A sheriff or a deputy sheriff of a county bordering the
 1-26 United Mexican States or of a county with a population of one [~~2.2~~]
 1-27 million or more is eligible to apply for certification under this
 1-28 section.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
