(b) If a vacancy on the executive board occurs before the 3 4 end of the vacating member's term, the executive board [of directors] shall elect a person to serve the remainder of the 5 [vacating member's] term [in the manner provided by Subsection 6 7 (a)]. To be eligible for election under this subsection, a person must meet any qualifications required of the vacating member for 8 9 service on the executive board.

10 (c) The executive board shall conduct the business of the 11 unit.

12 <u>(d) A majority of the members of the executive board</u> 13 <u>constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. The</u> 14 <u>executive board must approve any action by a majority vote of the</u> 15 <u>members present.</u>

SECTION 3. Subsection (d), Section 41.305, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(d) If a vacancy occurs in the office of presiding officer or assistant presiding officer <u>before the end of the vacating</u> <u>officer's term</u>, the <u>executive</u> board [of directors] shall elect a person to serve the remainder of the [vacating officer's] term [in <u>the manner provided by Subsection (a)</u>].

23 SECTION 4. Section 41.308, Government Code, is amended to 24 read as follows:

25 Sec. 41.308. CHIEF OF SPECIAL PROSECUTION UNIT; ADDITIONAL 26 EMPLOYEES. The <u>executive</u> board [of directors], on a majority vote, 27 shall employ a person to serve as chief of the unit and additional
