## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to DNA testing of biological evidence in certain capital
- 3 cases.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 38.43, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 7 (i) Before a defendant is tried for a capital offense in
- 8 which the state is seeking the death penalty, the Department of
- 9 Public Safety shall perform DNA testing on all biological evidence
- 10 that was collected as part of an investigation of the offense. The
- 11 state shall pay for all DNA testing performed in accordance with
- 12 this subsection.
- SECTION 2. Article 38.43(i), Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 14 added by this Act, applies only to a trial that commences on or
- 15 after the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the
- 16 alleged offense was committed before, on, or after that date.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
