1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to school district reports concerning corporal punishment
 1-21 and the issuance of citations by a peace officer.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 37.0011, Education Code, is amended by
 1-24 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-25 (e) A school district in which corporal punishment is
 1-26 permitted as a method of student discipline shall report in each
 1-27 district Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS)
 1-28 submission each instance during the period covered by the
 1-29 submission in which a district student is subject to the use of
 1-30 corporal punishment. The report:

1-31 (1) must include for each instance information
 1-32 identifying:

- 1-33 (A) the age of the student;
- 1-34 (B) the sex of the student;
- 1-35 (C) the race or ethnicity of the student; and
- 1-36 (D) whether the student is eligible for special

1-37 education services under Section 29.003;
 1-38 (2) must comply with the Family Educational Rights and
 1-39 Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g); and

1-40 (3) may not include personally identifiable student
 1-41 information.

1-42 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
 1-43 amended by adding Section 37.0811 to read as follows:

1-44 Sec. 37.0811. REPORT REGARDING CITATIONS ON CAMPUS.
 1-45 (a) In this section, "citation" means a ticket issued for a Class C
 1-46 misdemeanor.

1-47 (b) The commissioner shall adopt rules requiring a school
 1-48 district to report to the agency information relating to the
 1-49 issuance of citations by a peace officer to students on a district
 1-50 campus. The agency shall collect the reports required under this
 1-51 section, compile the data, and make the data available to the
 1-52 public.

1-53 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
 1-54 school year.

1-55 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-56 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-57 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-58 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-59 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
