BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 37.0011, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules requiring a school district to report to the agency information relating to the issuance of citations by a peace officer to students on a district campus. The agency shall collect the reports required under this section, compile the data, and make the data available to the public.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year.
