- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.2021 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.2021. TRANSPORTATION. The school district in which
- 8 <u>a student resides shall:</u>
- 9 <u>(1) provide each student attending another school in</u>
- 10 the district under this subchapter transportation free of charge to
- 11 and from the school the student attends; and
- 12 (2) provide each student attending a school in another
- 13 <u>district under this subchapter transportation free of charge to and</u>
- 14 from the school the student would otherwise attend.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 42.155, Education Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsections (g-1) and (g-2) to read as follows:
- 17 <u>(g-1) A school district that provides transportation</u>
- 18 services for students under Section 29.2021(1) to a campus in the
- 19 <u>district other than the student's campus of regular attendance is</u>
- 20 entitled to a state allocation paid on a previous year's
- 21 cost-per-mile basis. The maximum rate per mile allowable shall be
- 22 set by appropriation based on data gathered from the first year of
- 23 each preceding biennium.
- (g-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (g-1), the maximum rate

- 1 per mile allowable for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31,
- 2 2015, for purposes of that subsection shall be set by appropriation
- 3 based on available data. This subsection expires September 1,
- 4 2015.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 29.203(f), Transportation Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
