S.B. No. 1306

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the basic allotment for the Foundation School Program
3 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2013; making an
4 appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 4, H.B. 10, Acts of the 83rd Legislature,
7 Regular Session, 2013, is amended by amending Subsection (c) and
8 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

9 (c) Notwithstanding Rider 3 to the bill pattern of the
10 appropriations to the Texas Education Agency in Chapter 1355 (H.B.
11 1), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011 (the
12 General Appropriations Act), the basic allotment for the Foundation
13 School Program for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2013, is
14 \$4,867. In addition to amounts previously appropriated for the
15 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2013, the amount of
16 \$400,000,000 is appropriated out of general revenue account number
17 0193, Foundation School, for the state fiscal year ending August
18 31, 2013, to the Texas Education Agency under Strategy A.1.1, FSP -
19 Equalized Operations, as listed in Chapter 1355 (H.B. 1), Acts of
20 the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011 (the General
21 Appropriations Act), for the purpose of providing for the increase
22 in the basic allotment.

23 (d) Notwithstanding Rider 3 to the bill pattern of the
24 appropriations to the Texas Education Agency in Chapter 1355 (H.B.

1 1), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011 (the
2 General Appropriations Act), the sum certain appropriation to the
3 Foundation School Program for the state fiscal year ending August
4 31, 2013, is increased by the amount of \$1,030,000,000
5 [~~\$630,000,000~~].

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect only if House Bill No. 10,
7 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is enacted and becomes
8 law. If House Bill No. 10 is not enacted by the 83rd Legislature,
9 Regular Session, 2013, or does not become law, this Act has no
10 effect.

11 SECTION 3. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, this
12 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of
13 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,
14 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the
15 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
16 September 1, 2013.
