## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to continuing education requirements for certain public

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:		
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by		
6	adding Subsections (d), (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows:		
7	(d) Continuing education requirements for a classroom		
8	teacher must provide that 25 percent of the training required every		
9	five years include instruction regarding:		
10	(1) collecting and analyzing information that will		
11	improve effectiveness in the classroom;		
12	(2) recognizing early warning indicators that a		
13	student may be at risk of dropping out of school;		
14	(3) integrating technology into classroom		
15	instruction;		
16	(4) educating diverse student populations, including:		
17	(A) students with disabilities;		
18	(B) students who are educationally		
19	disadvantaged;		
20	(C) students of limited English proficiency; and		
21	(D) students with mental illness; and		
22	(5) increasing knowledge of the subject area taught by		
23	the educator.		
24	(e) Continuing education requirements for a principal must		

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1	provide that 25 percent of the training required every five years		
2	include instruction regarding:		
3	(1)	effective and efficient management, including:	
4		(A) collecting and analyzing information;	
5		(B) making decisions and managing time; and	
6		(C) supervising student discipline and managing	
7	behavior;		
8	(2)	recognizing early warning indicators that a	
9	student may be a	t risk of dropping out of school;	
10	(3)	integrating technology into campus curriculum and	
11	instruction;		
12	(4)	educating diverse student populations, including:	
13		(A) students with disabilities;	
14		(B) students who are educationally	
15	disadvantaged;		
16		(C) students of limited English proficiency; and	
17		(D) students with mental illness; and	
18	<u>(5)</u>	providing instructional leadership, including:	
19		(A) providing teacher support;	
20		(B) maintaining community involvement;	
21		(C) building professional learning communities;	
22	and		
23		(D) recruiting, coaching, remediating, and	
24	retaining campu	s educators.	
25	(f) Cont	inuing education requirements for a counselor must	
26	provide that 2	5 percent of training required every five years	
27	include instruction regarding:		

- 1 (1) assisting students in developing high school
- 2 graduation plans;
- 3 (2) implementing dropout prevention strategies; and
- 4 (3) informing students concerning:
- 5 (A) college admissions, including college
- 6 financial aid resources and application procedures; and
- 7 <u>(B) career opportunities.</u>
- 8 (g) Continuing education requirements for an educator each
- 9 year must be linked to any areas identified in the educator's
- 10 appraisal as needing improvement.
- 11 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2014, the State Board
- 12 for Educator Certification shall propose rules implementing
- 13 Section 21.054, Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. An educator subject to continuing education
- 15 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements
- 17 described by Section 21.054(d), (e), or (f), Education Code, as
- 18 added by this Act, for any continuing education requirements period
- 19 that ends before January 1, 2017.
- 20 SECTION 4. An educator subject to continuing education
- 21 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements
- 23 described by Section 21.054(g), Education Code, as added by this
- 24 Act, for any continuing education requirements period that ends
- 25 before January 1, 2016.
- SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2014-2015
- 27 school year.

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1 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
