5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:

7 (b-1) The agency, in conjunction with appropriate

8 interested persons, shall redevelop assessment instruments adopted

9 or developed under Subsection (b) for administration to

10 significantly cognitively disabled students in a manner consistent

11 with federal law. An assessment instrument under this subsection

12 may not require a teacher to prepare tasks or materials for a

13 student who will be administered such an assessment instrument.

14 (b-2) Assessment instruments redeveloped under Subsection

15 (b-1) shall be administered beginning not later than the 2014-2015

16 school year. This subsection expires September 1, 2015.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

21 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
