Any prompt for use in the administration of the assessment instrument must be 13 provided as supplementary information for the assessment 14 15 instrument. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19

20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
