CORRECTIONAL MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE OF TEXAS.<br>(a) In this section, "institute" means the Correctional<br>Management Institute of Texas.<br>(b) The Correctional Management Institute of Texas is<br>established for the training of criminal justice professionals.<br>The headquarters of the institute are at Sam Houston State<br>University. The institute is under the supervision and direction<br>of the president of Sam Houston State University may<br>establish rules relating to the institute.<br>(c) The president of Sam Houston State University shall<br>establish reasonable charges for participation in institute<br>training programs by participants who are not residents of this<br>state.
