- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 2.202(a) and (b), Family Code, are

- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to a marriage ceremony that is conducted on or after the effective
- 11 date of this Act. A marriage ceremony conducted before the
- 12 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 13 date the ceremony was conducted, and the former law is continued in
- 14 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
