5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 552, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 552.915 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.915. UTILITY CONTRACTS FOR CERTAIN
8	MUNICIPALITIES. (a) In this section, "utility system" means an
9	electric, water, sewer, solid waste disposal, drainage utility, or
10	natural gas system, or any combination of those systems.
11	(b) This section applies only to a municipality located in a
12	county:
13	(1) with a population of at least 375,000;
14	(2) that is located on an international border; and
15	(3) that borders the Gulf of Mexico.
16	(c) Notwithstanding any limitation provided by a home-rule
17	charter, the governing body, board of trustees, or other entity
18	vested with the management and control of the municipality's
19	utility system may contract for the purchase, sale, or transfer of
20	natural gas under terms the governing body, board of trustees, or
21	other entity considers appropriate.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
