4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article 179(e), Vernon's Civil Statues, is

amended by amending Section 6.15 to read as follows:

7 After an association has been granted a license to operate a

8 racetrack and before the completion of construction at the

9 designated place for which the license was issued, the commission

10 may, on application by the association, issue a temporary license

11 that permits the association to conduct races at a location in the

12 same county for a period expiring  $\underline{\text{ten}}$  [ $\underline{\text{two}}$ ] years after the date of

13 issuance of the temporary license or on the completion of the

14 permanent facility, whichever occurs first. The commission may set

15 the conditions and standards for issuance of a temporary license

16 and allocation of appropriate race days. An applicant for a

17 temporary license must pay the application fees and must post the

18 bonds required of other licensees before the issuance of a

19 temporary license. After a temporary license has expired, no

20 individual, corporation, or association, nor any individual

21 belonging to a corporation or association which has been granted a

22 temporary license, may get an extension of the temporary license or

23 a new temporary license.

24 SECTION 2. The commission shall grant an extension of up to

- 1 eight years for any association currently in possession of a
- 2 temporary license as described in Section 1 of this bill.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
