4	SECTION 1. Section 1901.001, Occupations Code, is amended
5	by adding Subdivision (13-a) and amending Subdivision (16) to read
6	as follows:
7	(13-a) "Third-party inspector" means a qualified
8	employee of a state agency with jurisdiction over wells, or a
9	qualified employee of a groundwater conservation district, who
10	assists the department with enforcement activities.
11	(16) "Well" means a water well, injection well,
12	dewatering well, closed-loop geothermal well, or monitoring well.
13	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1901, Occupations Code, is
14	amended by adding Section 1901.056 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 1901.056. REGIONAL WELL INSPECTION PROGRAM. (a) The
16	commission by rule shall establish a regional well inspection
17	<pre>program using third-party inspectors.</pre>
18	(b) Rules adopted under Subsection (a) shall establish:
19	(1) training requirements for a third-party
20	<pre>inspector;</pre>
21	(2) registration procedures for a third-party
22	inspector; and
23	(3) policies governing the acts of a third-party

inspector in conducting an inspection or investigation.
