- 2 relating to water well drillers and pump installers; authorizing
- 3 fees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1901.001, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subdivision (13-a) and amending Subdivision (16) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (13-a) "Third-party inspector" means a qualified
- 9 employee of a state agency with jurisdiction over wells who assists
- 10 the department with enforcement activities.
- 11 (16) "Well" means a water well, injection well,
- 12 dewatering well, <u>closed-loop geothermal well</u>, or monitoring well.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1901, Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 1901.0531 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 1901.0531. DRILLER AND PUMP INSTALLER TRAINING AND
- 16 ENFORCEMENT ACCOUNT. (a) The driller and pump installer training
- 17 and enforcement account is an account in the general revenue fund.
- 18 Administrative penalties collected under Subchapter F, Chapter 51,
- 19 for a violation of this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter
- 20 shall be deposited to the credit of the account.
- 21 (b) Funds in the account may be appropriated only to the
- 22 department for:
- 23 (1) promoting consumer awareness of this chapter and
- 24 Chapter 1902 and rules adopted under this chapter and Chapter 1902;

- 1 <u>and</u>
- 2 (2) supporting educational seminars, training
- 3 activities, or other projects designed to benefit the department's
- 4 ability to administer this chapter and Chapter 1902.
- 5 (b) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 6 other donations from any source for deposit into the account.
- 7 (c) The account is exempt from the application of Section
- 8 403.095, Government Code.
- 9 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 1901, Occupations Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 1901.056 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 1901.056. REGIONAL WELL INSPECTION PROGRAM. (a) The
- 12 commission by rule shall establish a regional well inspection
- 13 program using third-party inspectors.
- 14 (b) Rules adopted under Subsection (a) shall establish:
- 15 (1) training requirements for a third-party
- 16 <u>inspector;</u>
- 17 (2) registration procedures for a third-party
- 18 inspector; and
- 19 (3) policies governing the acts of a third-party
- 20 inspector in conducting an inspection or investigation.

- Sec. 1901.1532. JOURNEYMAN DRILLER. An applicant for a

- Sec. 1901.1533. APPRENTICE DRILLER. The commission by rule
- 22 shall set the fee for, establish the qualifications for, and
- 23 provide for the issuance of an apprentice driller license.
- SECTION 7. Section 1901.201(a), Occupations Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) The department shall offer examinations for each
- 27 license and endorsement at least once each year.

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- 1 SECTION 8. Section 1901.251(a), Occupations Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) Each driller who drills, deepens, or otherwise alters a
- 4 [water] well in this state shall make and keep a legible and
- 5 accurate well log in accordance with rules adopted by the
- 6 commission and on forms prescribed by the executive director. The

- 8 otherwise altering the well and must contain:
- 9 (1) the depth, thickness, and character of the strata
- 10 penetrated;
- 11 (2) the location of water-bearing strata;
- 12 (3) the depth, size, and character of casing
- 13 installed; and
- 14 (4) any other information required by rules adopted by
- 15 the commission.
- SECTION 9. Section 1901.255(d), Occupations Code, is

- 14 Sec. 1902.1531. LICENSE WITH SPECIALTY ENDORSEMENTS. (a)
- 15 An applicant for a license other than a master pump installer
- 16 license must:
- 17 (1) apply for a license with one or more specialty
- 18 endorsements described by Subsection (b);
- 19 (2) pass an examination for each endorsement for which
- 20 the applicant has applied; and
- 21 (3) satisfy other requirements as determined by
- 22 <u>commission rule.</u>
- 23 (b) The commission shall establish specialty endorsements
- 24 for:
- 25 (1) windmills, hand pumps, and pump jacks;
- 26 (2) single-phase pumps;
- 27 (3) three-phase pumps; and

- 1 (4) line-shaft turbine pumps.
- 2 Sec. 1902.1532. APPRENTICE PUMP INSTALLER. The commission
- 3 by rule shall set the fee for, establish the qualifications for, and
- 4 provide for the issuance of an apprentice pump installer license.
- 5 SECTION 14. Section 1902.201(a), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department shall offer examinations for each
- 8 license and endorsement at least once each year [month].
- 9 SECTION 15. The following sections of the Occupations Code
- 10 are repealed:
- 11 (1) Section 1901.201(b); and
- 12 (2) Section 1902.201(b).
- SECTION 16. (a) Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 14 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules to
- 15 implement the changes in law made by this Act to Chapters 1901 and
- 16 1902, Occupations Code.
- 17 (b) A person is not required to hold a license or license
- 18 specialty endorsement as a master driller, journeyman driller,
- 19 apprentice driller, master pump installer, or apprentice pump
- 20 installer issued under Chapter 1901 or 1902, Occupations Code,
- 21 before June 1, 2014.
- 22 SECTION 17. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
