- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 531, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 531.0058 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.0058. DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY SERVICES. Regardless 8 of where specific laboratory services are performed, or where a laboratory is physically located, any provider of diagnostic 9 10 laboratory services shall be eligible to participate in all health and human services programs as an in-state provider if the 11 provider, or its parent, subsidiary or affiliated company or 12 companies, individually or in the aggregate, maintain diagnostic 13 laboratory operations and employ at least 1000 persons within 14
- 16 <u>(b) This section does not impair the commission's authority</u>
 17 to refuse enrollment of a provider on the grounds that the provider
 18 is otherwise unqualified for enrollment.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
