A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to access to records and certain information in those records regarding a child placed for adoption. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 162.006, Family Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 1-24 follows:

The department, licensed child-placing agency, or other 1-25 (a) 1-26 person[, or entity] placing a child for adoption shall inform the 1-27 1-28 prospective adoptive parents of their right to examine the records and other information relating to the history of the child. The department, licensed child-placing agency, or other person [or entity] placing the child for adoption shall edit the records and 1-29 1-30 1-31 information to protect the identity of the biological parents and 1-32 any other person whose identity is confidential.

1-33 (a-1) The records described by Subsection (a) must include 1-34 any records relating to an investigation of abuse in which the child 1-35 was an alleged or confirmed victim of sexual abuse while residing in a foster home or other residential child-care facility. If the licensed child-placing agency or other person placing the child for adoption does not have the information required by this subsection, 1-36 1-37 1-38 the department, at the request of the licensed child-placing agency 1-39 or other person placing the child for adoption, shall provide the 1-40 information to the prospective adoptive parents of the child. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 1-41 1-42

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
