1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to State Board of Education oversight of regional
 1-22 education service center activities concerning certain curriculum
 1-23 management systems.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 8, Education Code, is
 1-26 amended by adding Section 8.0531 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 8.0531. INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS DEVELOPED BY A
 1-28 COLLABORATION OF REGIONAL EDUCATION SERVICE CENTERS.

1-29 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter or Section
 1-30 8.001(c), instructional lessons developed as part of a curriculum
 1-31 management system by a regional education service center, acting
 1-32 alone or in collaboration with one or more other regional education
 1-33 service centers, shall be subject to the same review and adoption
 1-34 process as outlined in Section 31.022.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
