## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to certain retail public utilities affected by single

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (j), Section 13.255, Water Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (j) This section shall apply only in a case where:
- 8 (1) the retail public utility that is authorized to
- 9 serve in the certificated area that is annexed or incorporated by
- 10 the municipality is a nonprofit water supply or sewer service
- 11 corporation, a special utility district under Chapter 65, Water
- 12 Code, or a fresh water supply district under Chapter 53, Water Code;
- 13 [<del>or</del>]
- 14 (2) the retail public utility that is authorized to
- 15 serve in the certificated area that is annexed or incorporated by
- 16 the municipality is a retail public utility, other than a nonprofit
- 17 water supply or sewer service corporation, and whose service area
- 18 is located entirely within the boundaries of a municipality with a
- 19 population of 1.7 million or more according to the most recent
- 20 federal census; or
- 21 (3) the retail public utility that is authorized to
- 22 serve in the certificated area that is annexed or incorporated by
- 23 the municipality is a retail public utility, other than a nonprofit
- 24 water supply or sewer service corporation, and the service area to

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- 1 be acquired is located entirely within the boundaries of a
- 2 municipality with a population of more than 30,000 that is in a
- 3 county that has a population of less than 90,000 and borders Lake
- 4 Ray Hubbard.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
