1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the exemption of the Corpus Christi Aquifer Storage and  
1-24 Recovery Conservation District from certain provisions concerning  
1-25 the desired future conditions of an aquifer.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 8811.005, Special District Local Laws  
1-28 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 8811.005. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. (a) Except as  
1-30 otherwise provided by this chapter, Chapter 36, Water Code, applies  
1-31 to the district.

1-32 (b) The following provisions of Chapter 36, Water Code, do  
1-33 not apply to the district:

1-34 (1) Sections 36.063(b) and (c);

1-35 (2) Sections 36.1071(a)(8) and (e)(3)(A);

1-36 (3) Sections 36.108(c)(4), (d), (d-1), (d-2), (d-3),  
1-37 and (d-4);

1-38 (4) Section 36.1083;

1-39 (5) Section 36.1084;

1-40 (6) Section 36.1085; and

1-41 (7) Section 36.1132.

1-42 (c) An affected person may not file a petition with the  
1-43 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality under Section 36.1082,  
1-44 Water Code, requesting an inquiry in connection with the district  
1-45 for a reason provided by Subsection (b)(4), (5), (6), or (7) of that  
1-46 section.

1-47 (d) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality may not  
1-48 take action against the district under Section 36.3011, Water Code,  
1-49 based on a finding under Subdivision (4), (5), (6), or (7) of that  
1-50 section.

1-51 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
1-52 to a petition filed under Section 36.1082 or 36.1083, Water Code, on  
1-53 or after the effective date of this Act. A petition filed before  
1-54 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when  
1-55 the petition was filed, and that law is continued in effect for that  
1-56 purpose.

1-57 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-58 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-59 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-60 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2-1 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
